Dear Customer,

congratulations on the purchase of your new Porsche child restraint. This operating instructions provided for your information and to assist you with the installation and use of your Porsche child restraint. In order that you better understand the safety and comfort issues associated with Porsche child restraint, Porsche recommends that you read this operating instructions carefully before installing or using a child restraint in your Porsche vehicle.

This operating instructions discribes the following Porsche child restraints.



Porsche Baby Seat LATCH, GO+ Valid only for children whose weight is 29 pounds (13 kg) or less and height is 31 inches (80 cm) or less.



Porsche Junior Seat LATCH, G1 Valid only for children who weigh between 20 - 40 pounds (9 - 18 Kg) and whose height is between 31 - 38 inches (80 - 97 cm).



Porsche Junior Plus Seat, G2 + G3 Valid only for children who weigh between 40 - 80 pounds (15 - 36 Kg) and whose height is 60 inches (152 cm) or less.

Installation in your vehicle

If you have any questions concerning the installation and safe operation of Porsche child restraint, your Porsche Dealership Sales and Service personel can assist and advise you.

This operating instructions is valid in the United States.

Observe the safety notes in the chapter "Child restraint systems" of the vehicle Owner's Manual when using the Porsche child restraint.

The Porsche child restraint seat should always be used on the rear seat of the vehicle.

Safety instructions in the Operating Instructions

Failure to observe safety instructions in the "Danger" category will result in serious injury or death.



Possible Serious Injury or Death

NOTICE

Possible child restraint Damage

General Safety Information

General Safety Information applies to the following Child restraint systems:

- Porsche Baby Seat LATCH
- Porsche Junior Seat LATCH
- Porsche Junior Plus Seat

Porsche recommends that all infants and children be restrained in child restraint systems at all times while the vehicle is in motion in accordance with applicable laws.

Use only child restraint systems recommended by Porsche. These systems have been tested and adjusted to the interior of your Porsche and the appropriate child age groups. Other systems have not been tested and could entail an increased risk of injury.

A DANGER

Improper Installation or Use

Serious Injury or Death can occur due to improper installation or use of Porsche child restraints.

- ▶ Porsche child restraints are designed to be secured with the vehicle belt restraint or LATCH systems as specified in these instructions.
- ▶ Read through this Operating Instructions and the vehicle Owner's Manual carefully. Pay particular attention to the "Child restraint systems" sections in vehicle Owner's Manual.

WARNING

Seat Adjustment while Driving

Risk of serious injury or death possible due to loss of control of the vehicle if you are distracted from driving.

- ▶ Never make any adjustments on the Porsche child restraint while driving.
- ▶ When infants and young children are to be transported in your vehicle, ensure that their child seats or other restraint devices are properly installed and adjusted **before** starting your Porsche vehicle.

To reduce the risk of serious or fatal injury to a child in the event of an accident, sharp braking maneuvers or sudden changes of directions:

Always secure children in restraint systems appropriate for the size and weight of the child. Never allow a child (or children) to sit on another occupant's lap while traveling in the vehicle. Due to the powerful fores involved, a child (or children) sitting on the lap of another vehicle occupant cannot be restrained in the event of an accident sharp braking maneuvers or sudden changes of direction. The child (or children) could be thrown against parts of the vehicle interior and be seriously or even fatally injured.

WARNING

Do not leave children unattended in the vehicle, even if they are secured in a child restraint system. The children could:

- ▷ injure themselves on parts of the vehicle
- be seriously or fatally injured as a result of prolonged exposure to extreme heat or cold
- injure other persons by operating the power windows, the sliding sunroof, the power seats or other vehicle functions, depending on the vehicle's equipment.
- ▶ If the children open a door, they could:
- ▷ injure other persons
- get out of the vehicle and injure themselves or be injured by a passing vehicle or other.

WARNING

According to accident statistics, children in a suitable child seat are better protected when the child seat is properly installed in one of the rear seats rather than on the front passenger seat. You should therefore install the child seat preferably on one of the outer seats in the rear. Otherwise, the chances of a child being seriously or fatally injured in the event of an accident, sharp braking maneuvers or sudden changes of direction will be inceased.

Safety Function

Loss of safety function.

- ▶ Regularly inspect all important parts for signs of damage. Make sure that the mechanical components function properly.
- ▶ The child restraint must be replaced if it was damaged or was stressed in an accident.
- ▶ If your child restraint, or individual parts of it (e.g. seat cover, etc.) are damaged (e.g. after falling, the seat must be checked by a qualified specialist workshop and, if necessary, replaced.
- ▷ Do not guide the belt straps of the safety belt over sharp edges. Belt straps in contact with sharp edges become damaged or torn as a result.
- ▶ Make sure that the child restraint is not trapped between hard parts (vehicle door, seat rails, etc).
- ▶ Never use a child restraint without prior knowledge of its history as you may never be certain wether its meets original manufacturer specification (e.g. accident damage, pending recalls, pieces missing, etc.).

WARNING

Only allow children to get into or out the vehicle on the side furthest away from traffic.

WARNING

Danger of severe or mortal injuries if there are unsecured persons or objects in the vehicle. Make sure that

- be the backrest of the vehicle is locked.
- ▷ all heavy and sharp-edged parts in the vehicle
- ▷ all people in the vehicle are secured.
- ▶ you secure the child restaint with the threepoint seat belt or the LATCH fastening system when it is not in use.

WARNING


Risk of serious personal injury or death to the child. Follow all child restraint instructions. warnings in this manual and the warnings which are labeled on the child restraint system.

- ▶ When using an infant or child restraint system. be sure to follow all manufacturer's instructions on installation and use.
- ▷ Infants and small children should never be held on the lap, nor should they share a safety belt with another occupant while the vehicle is in
- ▶ Children too big for child restraint systems should use regular safety belts. A shoulder belt can be used providing it does not cross the face or the neck of the child.

Danger of severe or mortal injuries if the following instructions are not followed.

- ▶ Never use this child restraint with motorized belts, belts with attachments in the vehicle door or side facing seats.
- ▶ The child restraint may only be installed in the location specially designated by the vehicle manufacturer. Please also comply with the vehicle Operator's Manual.

Safety Information

Child restraint on the front passenger seat

If you intend to use a child restraint on the front passenger' seat please refer to the vehicle Owner's Manual chapter "Child restraint systems".

If your vehicle is equipped with a passenger airbag off system please take note of the green "AIRBAG OFF" symbol on your child restraint.



If your vehicle is **not** equipped with a passenger airbag off system please take note of the red. circle and slash "AIRBAG OFF" symbol on your child restraint.



If in doubt please see your authorized Porsche dealer.

WARNING

Danger of severe injuries if you abruptly change the direction of travel, brake heavily or have an accident.

- ▶ The child restraint's protective function is only ensured when the child restraint is both installed and used properly.
- ▶ Therefore, be sure to precisely follow each individual step of the operating instructions. Comply with the warning notes and safety precautions as well as the corresponding sections in the vehicle Owner's Manual.
- ▶ You should pay particular attention to the information on the safety belts, airbags and child restraint system.

A DANGER

Passenger Airbag

Passenger airbags can cause severe or mortal injuries to children when they are triggered.

- ▶ In all vehicles, it is impermissible to use the child seat on the front passenger seat without deactivating the passenger airbag.
- ▶ If your vehicle is equipped with a passenger airbag off system please take note of the green "AIRBAG OFF" symbol on your child restraint.
- ▶ If your vehicle is **not** equipped with a passenger airbag off system please take note of the red, circle and slash "AIRBAG OFF" symbol on your child restraint.
- Please observe the chapter "Child restraint systems" in the vehicle Owner's Manual.

WARNING

If the passenger front airbag is not switched off. only install the child safety seat in one of the rear seats that is suitable for this purpose.

- ▶ Please observe the chapter "Child restraint systems" in the vehicle Owner's Manual.
- ▶ If in doubt please see your authorized Porsche dealer.

WARNING

Deactivated passenger airbags do not provide any protection in an accident.

▶ Reactivate the passenger airbag after removing the child seat.

WARNING

Passenger airbags can cause severe or mortal injury to children when they are triggered.

▶ In all vehicles, it is impermissible to use the child seat on the front passenger seat without deactivating the passenger airbag.

Danger of severe injuries if you abruptly change the direction of travel, brake heavily or have an accident.

- ▶ The child restraint may only be installed in a rearward-facing direction inside the vehicle.
- ▶ Make sure that the child restraint's shoulder belts and belt buckle fit snugly against the child's body and are not twisted.
- ▶ If you use the child seat on the rear seat (**not 911**), move the front seat as far forward as possible, so that the child does not come into contact with the front seat.
- ▶ Position the front seat backrest vertically.
- ▶ No modification may be made to child restraint, the safety belts or the fastening points.
- ▷ Since the cover represents an important part of the safety function, the child seat must not be used without the cover.

A CAUTION

Hot Plastic Parts

Danger of burns by hot plastic parts on the child seat if the seat was exposed to the sun.

▶ Protect the child seat against exposure to intense sunlight.

NOTICE

Damage of child restraint. The child restraint is designed for transporting children.

▷ Do not place any heavy or sharpedged objects in or on the child restraint, even if it has been removed from the vehicle.

WARNING

Unsecured persons or objects

Danger of severe or mortal injuries if there are unsecured persons or objects in the vehicle. Make sure that

- ▶ the backrest of the vehicle is locked.
- ▷ all heavy and sharp-edged parts in the vehicle are secured.
- ▷ all people in the vehicle are secured.
- vou secure the child restaint with the threepoint seat belt or the LATCH fastening system when it is not in use.

This child restraint system conforms to all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety standards.

This child restraint is not certified for aircraft use.



Do not make any modifications to the Porsche Baby Seat LATCH and do not use any unsuitable accessories. Otherwise the warranty will be rendered invalid.

¹⁾ Never install this child restraint in the front passenger seat of a vehicle that has a passenger airbag, unless the airbag is switched off. When possible, it is strongly recommended that all child restraints be placed in the rear of the vehicle.

Securing your child in place

WARNING

Danger of severe or mortal injuries if the following instructions are not followed.

- ▷ Always secure your baby in the child restraint.
- ▶ Never leave your baby out of your sight when you place him or her on a raised surface (e.g. changing table, tabletop...).
- ▶ Take your child out of the child restraint as often as possible to take the pressure of his/ her column. To do so, take frequent breaks from driving when on lengthier trips. When you are outside of the vehicle, do not leave your child in the child restraint for too long.



Removing the Support Cushion

The support cushion (1) improves the ergonomic properties for your baby.

You can use the support cushion until your baby is large enough that you have to adjust the headrest (2) height out of the bottom position.

1. Take the support cushion (1) out of the pocket in the headrest cover.



Adjusting the Carrying Handle

You can engage the carrying handle in three positions:

- 1. Simultaneously press both buttons (3) on the carrying handle (4).
- 2. With the buttons (3) pressed, swivel the carrying handle (4) forward or back until the carrying handle engages in the desired position.

Carrying Handle

Danger of severe or mortal injuries if the carrying

handle is not properly engaged.

▷ Check whether the carrying handle is engaged by holding the child restraint and moving the carrying handle back and forth.



Position A Carrying and transport in the vehicle



Position B Laying down and buckling in your baby




Position C Secure stand outside the vehicle



Adapting the Headrest A properly adapted headrest provides ideal support for your baby in the child restraint.

The headrest (2) must be adjusted so that the shoulder belts (5) are at or slightly below the shoulder height of your baby.



Adjusting the Headrest

- 1. Open the buckle.
- 2. Tilt the headrest adjuster (6) out of the lock.



3. Push the headrest adjuster (6) to the correct belt height and engage the headrest adjuster.



Loosening the shoulder belts

1. Press the adjusting button (7) and simultaneously pull the two shoulder belts (5) forward.



Buckling in your Baby


- 1. Loosen the shoulder belts (refer to section "Loosening the shoulder belts").
- **2.** Open the buckle (8) (press the red button).
- **3.** Put your baby into the child restraint.




Twisted or Interchanged Shoulder Belts

Twisted or interchanged shoulder belts can severely injure your child.

- ▶ Do not twist or interchange the shoulder belts.
- **4.** Guide the shoulder belts (5) over your baby's shoulders.



5. Bring the belt tongues (9) together



6. and insert the belt tongues into the buckle **(8)** until you hear them engage. **CLICK!**

Improper Child Restraint Use

- Risk of injury if your child is buckled in improperly.

 Make sure that the belt tongues are properly engaged in the buckle.

 Make sure that the shoulder belts fit snugly.

 Make sure that the shoulder belts are not too tight against the neck.



7. Pull the end of the belt (11) until the shoulder belts are snug against your baby's body.



The lap belts (10) must pass as low as possible over your child's hips.

WARNING

End of Belt

Risk of injury if the following instructions are not

▶ Never trap the end of the belt in moving parts (e.g. automatic doors, escalators...).



Securing your Child properly

Danger of severe or mortal injuries if your child is buckled in improperly.

In the interests of your child's safety, check that...

- the shoulder belts of the child restraint are snug against the body without constricting the
- the shoulder belts (5) are correctly adjusted.
- the shoulder belts are not twisted.
- the belt tongues (9) are correctly engaged in the buckle (8).
- the head restraint has been correctly adjusted.

Fastening in the vehicle

WARNING

Improper Child Restraint Use

Danger of severe or mortal injuries if the child seat is not installed properly

- ▶ The entire base of the child restraint must always be resting directly on the seat cushion surface of the vehicle seat.
- ▶ Never place anything underneath the child restraint (e.g. blackets/covers).



Fastening the child restraint with LATCH System

- 1. Take the LATCH belt (12) out the net (14).
- 2. Position the child restraint onto the rear seat against the direction of travel (baby faces to the rear).

1 Information

If the child restraint is too unstable or not flat on the seat, select a different seat.




- 3. Make sure that the carrying handle (4) is in the top position A (refer to section "Adjusting the carrying handle").
- 4. Press the right-hand LATCH belt buckle (when looking in the direction of travel) (16) onto the LATCH bar (13) of the seat so that it engages audibly. CLICK!
- 5. Insert the LATCH belt (12) into the pale blue seat belt guides (36) on both sides of the child restraint.



Information

Do not twist the belt



- 6. Press the left-hand LATCH belt buckle (15) onto the left LATCH bar (17) of the seat so that it also engages audibly.
- 7. Firmly press the child restraint against the seat backrest, and tighten the LATCH belt (12) by pulling the loose ends of the belt (18) on both sides of the child restraint.


A DANGER

Incorrectly Installed Child Restraint

An incorrectly installed child restraint cannot protect the child as intended in the event of an accident, sharp braking maneuvers or sudden changes of direction and may lead to serious or fatal injuries to the child or other vehicles occupants.

In the interest of your child's safety, make sure that:


- ▶ the child restraint is secured in a rear-facing position opposite the vehicle's forward direction of travel.
- ▶ the child restraint is only installed on the frontpassenger seat as long as no front airbag can deploy in the direction of the child restraint.
- ▶ the child restaint is secured with the LATCH belt.



- b the Latch belt (12) passes though the two pale blue seat guides (36) on the the edges of the the child restraint.
- both LATCH belt buckles (16) und (15) properly engagend in the LATCH bars of the seat.



 b the LATCH belt (27) is pulled taut and not twisted.



Removal the child restraint with **LATCH System**

- 1. Press the button (19) on both tension buckles of the LATCH belt (27) and loosen the belt.
- 2. Press the red button (20) on the left and right LATCH belt buckle, and release the LATCH belt from the LATCH bars.
- 3. Store the LATCH belt in the net, and take the child restraint out of the vehicle.




Fastening the child restraint with the Three-Point Seat Belt

1. Position the child restraint onto the rear seat against the direction of travel (baby faces to the rear).



If the child restraint is too unstable or not flat on the seat, select a different seat.

- 2. Make sure that the carrying handle (4) is in position A (refer to section "Adjusting the Carrying Handle")
- 3. Pull the vehicle's three-point seat belt out and guide it over the child restraint.
- 4. Insert the belt tongue into the buckle (34).



5. Lay the lap belt (35) into the pale blue belt guides (36) on both sides of the child restraint edge.



6. Pull the diagonal belt (37) behind the top end of the child restraint.



7. Push the diagonal belt (37) between the dark blue holder (38) and the child restraint until the belt engages.



Do not twist the three-point seat belt.

8. Tighten the diagonal belt.

Installing your child restraint correctly




Incorrectly Installed Child Restraint

An incorrectly installed child restraint cannot protect the child as intended in the event of an accident, sharp braking maneuvers or sudden changes of direction and may lead to serious or fatal injuries to the child or other vehicles occupants.

In the interest of your child's safety, make sure


- b the child restraint is secured in a rear-facing position opposite the vehicle's forward direction of travel.
- ▶ the child restraint is only installed on the frontpassenger seat as long as no front airbag can deploy in the direction of the child restraint.
- b the child restaint is secured with a lap-shoulder belt as indicated in this operation instruction.



- b the lap belt (35) passes through the two pale blue belt guides (36) at the edge of the child restraint.
- b the diagonal belt (37) passes between the dark blue holder (38) and the child restraint.
- be the three-point seat belt is pulled taut and not twisted.




▶ The buckle (34) must not lie in the light blue belt guide (36) or be positioned so far forward that it lies in front of (in the direction of travel) the pale blue belt guide (36).




Removing the child restraint with the Three-Point Seat Belt

1. Push the dark blue holder (38) slightly away from the child restraint to disengage the diagonal belt (37).



- Open the buckle (34) and take the lap belt (35) out of the pale blue belt guides (36).
 Return the three-point seat belt (35) to its
- original position. **4.** Remove the child restraint.



Fastening the child restraint with a Lap Belt

5. Position the child restraint onto the rear seat against the direction of travel (baby faces to the rear).



Information

If the child restraint is too unstable or not flat on the seat, select a different seat.

Malfunction:

- The LATCH belt buckles no longer engage onto the LATCH bars.

- The LATCH belt buckles can only be opend with a great deal of force.

Remedy:

- Have the LATCH belt buckles checked by an authorized Porsche Dealer, and replaced if necessary.

▶ the belt tongue and the vehicle buckle (13) of the lap belt do **not** lie in the belt guide (15) of the Porsche Junior Seat LATCH.



Adapting the Headrest

A correctly adapted headrest (20) will provide optimum support for your child in the Porsche Junior Seat LATCH.

The headrest (20) must be adjusted so that the shoulder belts (19) are at or slightly above the shoulder height of your child.




Adjusting the Headrest
